tool. Students are really using the netbooks, and learning how to use the spell check. There is a lot of multitasking going on with students self selecting activities and tasks. They also are working as peer helpers. Third grade is starting the podcasts on native birds. They are using *Storybird* to write about wishes and publishing their stories online. In science, they are studying the human body. They are working on multiplication in math.

Three teachers are attending the National STA in Indianapolis. Kathy will work with Sue to get an article in the paper about charter school enrollment and how students are chosen to participate in DCS. Suzy applied for a couple of garden grants and is waiting to hear the results. Special community events will go out through Sue's mass e-mail and put on the DCS website.

#### 2. Green Team

The team continues to work on recycling. Prices are down a little, but they continue to take the cans in.

## 3. Strategic Plan

Sue has developed a goal to work on her background knowledge as it relates to the goals and curriculum of the Charter School. She thought it would be helpful if the charter governance council would make suggestions for other goals that the council would like to see her meet. Sue is working on this as part of her professional PDP and her administrative review. The strategic plan will be part of the report to the School Board in August. It was decided that her professional development plan should be part of her evaluation plan rather than putting it in the Strategic Plan. DCS will participate in the Green Charter School Network, but postpone application for Green School status at this time. The process and requirements have become more involved. The council and DCS staff will begin planning for writing another dissemination grant. Christine offered to work on grant writing. Tonya will make changes to the Strategic Plan for the final copy to be voted on at the March meeting. The plan will be shred via e-mail and the wiki with council members. A suggestion was made to consider expanding DCS summer school opportunities.
