1. Welcome to Paul Vande Hei- potential community member. Discussion on changing the meeting date to another Tuesday. Tonya will check with Stephanie for her availability.

2. Updates- Sue and Teachers

Kindergarten students are growing Amaryllis bulbs. Peggy wrote and was awarded a Pet in the Classroom Grant. First Grade is working on woodland creatures unit. They are following up with learning logs for their research and will pull out facts to create animal reports. The reports will focus on the physical characteristics, habitats and species details. The final product will be integrated with student artwork. Student writing is scaffolded to build on curriculum at later grades. Dawn has a high school assistant to work with the students on their writing. The student assistants are coordinated with the guidance program. Council members thought it would be a good idea to expand the student assistance program. Second Grade is continuing to work on non-fiction writing. Publishing will look different based on how the students choose to organize their products. Science is focusing on energy. They had an author visit that focused on food chains. The charter school is planning a trip to the woods. Suzy would like to start stream monitoring at Astico, or similar site in the future. The third graders planted seeds. Everything is up and out in the greenhouse. Students have been independently watering the plants. Bird podcasts are beginning with recording starting. The third grade is also working on Photosynthesis. The planters are out and ready for plants.

3. **Event Planning Committee** met on 3/20/12. They will have activities ready for students for the open house. Suggestion was made to potentially have a family night at the garden. The food
