1. Updates- Sue and Teachers

- a. Green Team will meet this Thursday.
- b. Event Committee Met and set the fall clean-up date: Sunday, October 7th from 1-4 PM. The rain date will be Sunday, October 14th from 1-4 PM. The committee decided to plan an Astico winter family activity (similar to last year) as well as a spring clean-up day.

c. Teachers

- Peggy Students are practicing classroom routines. They are working on a living and non-living science unit. They have also used the hand-lenses to explore the schoolyard gardens.
- ii. Dawn Students are also practicing classroom routines. They have been working on Spelling, Math, Writing and Responding to Reading. They have discussed features of non-fiction texts and will soon be getting into a nonfiction writing unit. Students are working on gaining independence in the classroom.

- iii. Katie Students have been working on establishing Reading and Writing Workshop routines. They have begun Spelling. They have a bearded dragon classroom pet as well as various aquatic animals. Students have been learning about caring for the pets. Students have been making observations of schoolyard.
- iv. Suzy Students have established Reader's and Writer's Workshop routines. They have begun math and are learning how to care for the classroom pets. In science they have been working on Childhood Maps (places they play outside.) They will soon begin a Narrative Writing unit connected to these maps. DCS will be harvesting garden produce soon and the classes will prepare a Harvest Soup and possibly a chili in the next few weeks.
- Annual Report A journalist (Terri Peterson) from the Beaver Dam newspaper visited DCS today to capture DCS students in action. Sue shared some of the annual report information with Terri.

Sue shared the PowerPoint presentation with the Council she gave to the School Board in August. Sue mentioned that the DCS Budget Committee possibility will need more discussion to get School Board approval.

Sue went to the No Teacher Left Inside Institute over the summer (funded through dissemination grants received by a Charter school up north.) Sue is hoping to host a NTLII here at DCS in the summer of 2014 (with the aid of receiving a dissemination grant.) DCS could write in the request for a Via Com system through this potential grant. Victoria Rynberg would assist DCS in writing the grant (due the end of April.) Ms. Rynberg is coming in mid-October to meet with Sue regarding our ideas about this dissemination grant. Tonya suggested examining our previous grant applications in helping us with the grant application process. Sue will share information at a future meeting regarding this grant's requirements. Sue mentioned a possible source of funding: deeming the DCS woods a School Forest. Sue will let the Council know if there is anything we can do to help Victoria with the grant application process as well as the pursuance of a School Forest. Sue will update Council in November. Sue suggested that CES pursue becoming a Green Ribbon School.

The School Board has inquired about expanding the Charter school into 4th and 5th grade.

Laura gave an update on the Facilities Committee happenings.

The Council decided to revisit the discussion of potential grants to help expand the Charter School to 4th and 5th grade.

All CES teachers are using Curriculum Companion to document ELA curriculum. Current Master Schedule allows all DCS teachers a common planning time, daily.
