- 2. Dissemination Grant Activities (Annual report may be presented in August)
 - a. Katie shared that DCS teachers have been working on completing their NGSS aligned Framework for Elementary Science. They have also used grant funds to order materials for various units throughout the year. Sue and the teachers have also gone to several science PD conferences this past year with funds. This grant ends July 30th, 2014. DCS will find out in August if they got the Dissemination Grant Renewal for another \$125,000.
- 2. **Strategic Planning Updates** The Strategic Planning Committee will reconvene in the fall. The current Strategic Plan will go through the end of 2014. In the fall, a new Strategic Plan will be drafted.
- 3. **Fundraising Updates/End of Year Items** Melody shared fund raising profits from soccer game concession sales (\$203.20). The Clothing Fundraiser raised \$32. We will try the clothing fundraiser again in the fall of 2014. Melody planted flowers at the train station (Melody's mom donated the flowers.) Greenhouse plant sales are at about \$605 for the year so far.
